Douglas A. Dompier, age 79, of Apex, passed away on June 18, 2026.

He was born June 29, 1946, in Grosse Pointe, Michigan, the son of the late Wilfred H. Dompier and Mary Elizabeth (Schulte) Dompier. He spent most of his youth in the Parma Heights area of Cleveland, Ohio.

After attending Ohio State University for a year, Doug proudly joined the Marine Corps and served a tour in Vietnam.

Doug married his wife, Jeanne, in 1972, and after living in Ohio and New Jersey, they moved to Billerica, Massachusetts in 1977.

Doug was an active member of St. Theresa of Lisieux Parish, where he served as a Eucharistic Minister and generously gave his time and talents supporting decorations, seasonal appointments and helping care for the church. He also volunteered with the St. Vincent de Paul Society, serving those in need in the Billerica community.

Doug was a dedicated member of the Billerica Knights of Columbus and, alongside his brother Knights, led a gym program for special needs children for over ten years. He served as Vice President of Production at a precision sheet metal company before retiring to North Carolina to spend time with his

grandchildren.

In addition to his wife of 54 years, he is survived by his son, David Dompier, and his wife, Adriane; six grandchildren; his brothers Tom, Scott, and Don; and his sister Deb, along with several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his sister Barb and his brother Ron.

A Funeral Mass will be held at St. Andrew the Apostle Church in Apex on Friday, June 26 at 11:00 a.m. Inurnment will follow immediately afterward in the Columbarium.
