Mark Adam Berbert, of Pittsboro, North Carolina, passed away on June 16, 2026, after a brief battle with cancer. He was born on December 15, 1959, in Mount Vernon, New York, to Roy Berbert and Jacqueline (Benson) Berbert.

Mark moved to North Carolina in 1970 and graduated from J.H. Rose High School in Greenville in 1977. He attended Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory and later studied programming at Pitt Community College. Mark was also largely self-taught, with a natural ability for technology, logic, and problem-solving.

In the early 1980s, Mark moved to Raleigh to work for Management Systems Associates. He retired from Altera Health in January 2025 after 36 years as a software engineer in the digital healthcare solutions industry.

Mark was preceded in death by his parents, Roy Berbert and Jacqueline (Benson) Berbert, and sister, Ruth (Berbert) Woods.

Mark is survived by his loving wife, Rebecca “Becky” (Hobart) Berbert; his brother, David Berbert and his wife, Amy; his niece, Emily Hall and her husband, Caleb; and two great-nephews, Carter and Oliver.
